How are we kept safe in the classroom?

We walk around the classroom.

We are kind to others.

We sit sensibly on our chairs and place them under the table when we are not using them.

We take care with equipment.

We listen to adults.

We ask adults if we need to leave the room.

We follow or class rules / charters.

Our Rights:

Article 3: Everyone who works with children should always do what is best for each child.

Article 19: You should not be harmed and looked after and kept safe.

Article 12: Your right to say what you think should happen and be listened to.

How are we kept safe around the school?

We keep doors closed.

We tell staff if we are worried about something.

We follow the rules when we are swimming.

We look after each other.

How do we stay safe on school trips?

We always wear a seatbelt on the bus.

We always stay together.

Adults always count us.

We have a partner.

We wear appropriate clothing.

How do we stay safe online?

We follow the E-Safety Rules.

We don't give out any personal details.

We only take photos if we have asked permission.

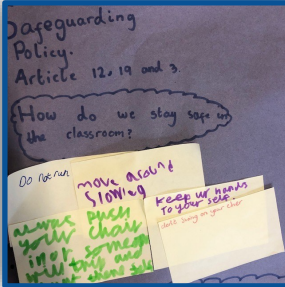
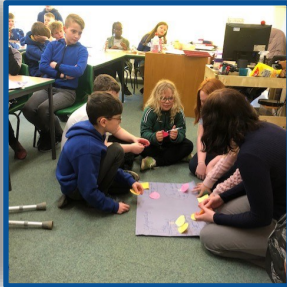
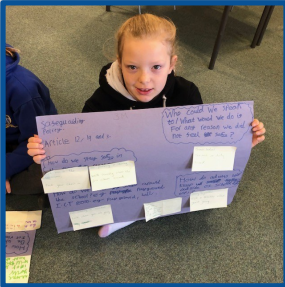
We think carefully about what we post online.
